9.45	<b>Malta Freeport</b>	This is the major maritime transshipment logistic centre in the Mediterranean region equipped with 23 Ship to Shore Post Panamax cranes capable of moving 25 boxes per hour. There are 6 kms of Quays with a draught of 17m. 78 RTGCs move containers in a yard with a capacity of 73,000 TEUs. The Freeport manages 2.3m TEUs per year, 95% are transshipments. When all the planned works will be completed, Malta Freeport Terminals will be increasing its quay length to over 3 kilometres and the annual capacity of more than 3 million TEUs.	
10.30	<b>Playmobil</b>	Playmobil is one of the oldest manufacturing companies in Malta. It has been manufacturing their range of toys on the island for almost 40 years. The Playmobil toy system appeared for the first time in 1974 at the International Toy Fair in Nuremberg. In 2003, the group moved into a new 38,000 m <sup>2</sup> factory, where 150 injection moulding machines are installed with a sophisticated system of printing and packaging processes. It is the largest factory in the plastics sector on Malta, producing around 50 millions smiling plastic figures per annum. The Maltese unit employs 700 highly specialised staff and exports goods worth 65 million euros per annum, essentially to Europe, the USA and Canada. Their success is based on continuous investment in new technologies in our processes and obviously coupled within them the investment in all their employees. The tour will include a view of manufacturing and distribution logistics operations.

14.00	<b>Valetta Cruise Liner Terminal</b>	<p>The past years showed continuous improvement in international cruising and the Maltese cruise sector has moved in parallel. The European cruise market particularly that for the Mediterranean is expanding year on year, while more and larger cruise ships are being deployed in the region. A very important development for the future of the Mediterranean cruising is the extension of the season with winter cruising.</p> <p>It is the ships themselves, and the quality and diversity of pleasures they provide as the world floats by, that are increasingly becoming an important attraction in their own right. Thus, mega-ships carrying 2,000 to 3,500 passengers and offering almost every conceivable amenity afloat have become the cruise industry's biggest success story.</p> <p>In 2008 VISET Malta plc's target of reaching half a million cruise passengers was comfortably exceeded with a total of 540,000 turnout, an increase of about 12 percent on the previous year. The all-time record for the port of Valletta in terms of ship numbers is eight ships in a single day. Meanwhile the busiest day ever in terms of guest numbers was registered on 2 May 2008, with six vessels in port, 12,729 guests and a total length on quay of 1.5 km.</p>
