Dear Patrick,

Thank you for your letter dated 25th January 2018 and addressed to the President and Trustee and a number of our Trustees.

I have been asked to respond to you on behalf of the Trustees who considered the content at their meeting on 1st March 2018.

The Trustees would like to point out that the decision to transfer the educational processes done for a number of years by CILT Ireland was taken by the International organisation in December 2017 and notice served to CILT Ireland on December 19th, 2017. We are now planning the orderly transfer in conjunction with the executive of CILT Ireland.

The International education process and education business is the responsibility of CILT International and CILT Ireland has been a willing partner in completing some of those process tasks. Over the years of the partnership we have worked together successfully on issues that have arisen with improvements made both in Ireland and in International, as well as with our global education partners. This has resulted in the continued growth of the education business and you share in that success.

The Trustees do not recognise or share the views expressed in your letter or the allegations of deficiencies made. CILT International will be carrying out our own review of process as we transfer the processes from Ireland and will use that to make improvements in the internal processes on transfer.

May I, on behalf of the Trustees, thank you for your cooperation and partnership over the years. The Trustees request that CILT Ireland recognise the joint success of our education business achieved over the years by working effectively together.
