SUBJECT: CILT NIGERIA REPORT TO IMC FOR MAY 3, 2018 MEETING

Please find herewith the report of the activities of CILT Nigeria for your attention.

1. Africa Forum

The Africa Forum held in Nigeria was successful as crème-de la-crème of the society both from local and international attended the programme. Officials of CILT International Council in attendance were the Int'l President, Int'l President Elect, IVP (Africa), the Secretary General and international education Coordinator. Also in attendance were Chairmen and members of the National Assembly, government reps, many members from eight African countries and over 250 delegates from Nigeria. Delegates were informed of the passage of the Institute's Bill by the National Assembly. The former Minister of Transport and also of Aviation organised a dinner for the delegates on March 14th, and was quite refreshing.

The meeting of the Forum on March 15, 2018 was impressive with the exception of the issues concerning the IVP for Africa/Chairman, Africa Forum.

WiLAT and YPs held their programmes with a number us attending.

Day three was devoted to guided tours: One for bicycles donation to Kwuali Women by WiLAT while others went for Rail and Abuja metropolis tour. There were also cultural dances, high life musical entertainment and interactions between delegates.

The next Forum will hold in Tanzania, East Africa. The date will be communicated in due course by CILT Tanzania.

We appreciate everyone for their contributions towards making the programme a huge success. In all, it was a beautiful outing.

2. **International Convention in Poland:** The promotion of the Convention is well on course as 32 delegates have so far been registered. More are expected to register. It should however be noted that the number of delegates that will eventually attend shall depend on visas outcome and other issues not envisaged as at now.
3. **Membership:** We had during the first quarter an average of 36 per month. That is 108 for the first quarter. We also registered 2 Corporate Members.
4. **Education:** There is a marginal improvement on the enrolment of students. This is attributable to the aggressive marketing of Training Providers, National Secretariat and support from members. Two new Training Providers and being assessed for possible accreditation.
5. **Industry Assignments:** The Institute was recently appointed to serve in the Ministerial Committee on Transport Working Group (TWG) of the National Road Safety Advisory Council.
6. Plans are on to set short, medium and long term agenda for the Institute.
