At the Savoy Hotel in London on 3 November 1919 a group of senior Transport professionals met determined to change the world of Logistics and Transport. ## LOCAL ACTIVITIES OF CILT BANGLADESH COUNCIL

### AIUB CILT Partner in Career Progress

American International University Bangladesh (AIUB), represented by Mr. Ashfaq A. Mohib, Associate Professor and Head of Department of Operations & Supply Chain Management



(OSCM) and Dr. Saad Hasan, Assistant Professor of Department of OSCM visited the corporate office of the Chartered Institute of Logistics and Transport (CILT), Council MHK Terminal, Kawran Bazar, Dhaka, Bangladesh, on March 5, 2018. CILT was represented by Capt. Gias Uddin Khan CMILT (Joint Secretary and Executive Committee Member), Mr. Muhammad Refayet Chowdhury MILT (Chairman, Young Professionals Forum) and Mr. Tanjil Ahmed Ruhullah CMILT (Vice-Chairman, YPF) to discuss regarding scope of collaboration with Department of OSCM, FBA, AIUB in offering CILT International Professionals Qualifications to faculty members and students, for academic and profession enrichment. It was a very fruitful session, as both representatives from AIUB and CILT look forward to mutual growth, together. The session was concluded with exchange of gifts, between both the parties.

### Young Professionals Forum (YPF) visits Pangaon ICT for hands on Experience

Chartered Institute of Logistics and Transport is keen on giving hands on systematic experiences to our young professionals in order for them to excel in their careers. In March 2018,





the Young Professional Forum (YP) of Chartered Institute of Bangladesh (CILT) council organized an expedition to Pangaon Inland Container terminal (ICT). The ICT is located in Keraniganj, covering a total area of 55,000 square meters. The Bangladesh Inland Water Transport Authority (BIWTA) and the Chittagong Port Authority (CPA) jointly built this inland terminal with a plan and vision that it will enhance the Economic development through trade and commerce.

The objective of the visit to ICT was for YP members to gain valuable insight and knowledge about the physical operations and activities that are currently implemented in the zone. When our team of young professionals entered the facility, we were cordially greeted with the traffic manager, Mr. Ahmedul Karim Chowdhury who gave us a guide who would take us through the area. First, the guide showed us the container freight station (CFS) which covers a large area of 5,815 square meters along with the operations carried out inside the CFS. Secondly, they showed us the reefer plug in point of the refrigerator containers that keep the entire cargo cool. Thirdly, the team observed the containers are loaded and unloaded to and from a ship, using a cargo lifting crane, straddle carrier and tractor trailer. Lastly, the traffic manager invited us to his office and gave a short presentation about the Pangaon ICT, the challenges that they are facing right now and further future prospects.

### **Annual YP Trip to Sundarban on March 27, 2018**

One of the goals of Chartered Institute of Logistics and Transport is to help implement the growth and skillset for all young professionals within the industry. Expanding their



influence over the younger career-oriented minds will ensure a longer



lifetime within the CILT family as well as chance to form a stronger community over time.

And for the first time, the Young professional forum (YPF) of CILT Bangladesh council took the initiative to organize an annual picnic to Sundarban, the largest mangrove forest in the world.
